

Von Roll Inova success in the Iberian market

As part of a consortium agreement, Von Roll Inova has been awarded an order for the enlargement of a waste treatment plant near Palma de Mallorca airport with two additional lines.

In view of new European legislation with regard to waste disposal, the Spanish market has long been a target for new thermal waste treatment projects. Now, in a consortium with its Spanish partner, Ros Roca, Von Roll Inova has been commissioned by the TIRME company with the completion of two waste treatment lines. TIRME, Tratamiento Industrial de Residuos del Mediterráneo, is the market leader for ecological waste treatment on the Balearics and the number one company worldwide for waste handling on islands.

As the consortium leader, Von Roll Inova is responsible for project management, the scope of deliveries including the entire process technology for waste incineration and flue gas cleaning. The two lines, which will both have a capacity of 70 MW will go into operation at Son Reus in mid-2009.

The decisive factor in the allocation of this project to Von Roll Inova, was confidence in the highly experienced Swiss company's proven technology. In addition, the stringent stipulations with regard to environmental compatibility, which should underpin Mallorca's image as a holiday island, were also of major significance.

With this contract, Von Roll Inova has achieved re-entry into the southern European market, where increasing demand for ecologically and cost efficient waste treatment concepts can be anticipated in years to come.
