

## **Follow up success for Austrian Energy & Environment CZ in Pakistan**

Austrian Energy & Environment CZ signed a contract with the EPC contractor ŠKODAEXPORT on September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2007 for the Muridke Combined Cycle power plant in Pakistan.

The scope of supply includes the design and delivery of two heat recovery steam generators behind GE gas turbine 6FA (70MW) including feed water system. The supervision of erection and commissioning are further responsibilities of AE&E CZ.

The plant output is 234 MW. The gas turbines will use natural gas and high-speed diesel oil. The HRSGs themselves are unfired.

The plant is scheduled to start operation in June 2009.

This contract is a result of the successful and long-term cooperation with ŠKODAEXPORT.
